

THE "WASHINGTON POST HUNT" SWEEPSTAKES OFFICIAL RULES

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. A PURCHASE WILL NOT INCREASE YOUR CHANCE OF WINNING.

ELIGIBILITY: The "Washington Post Hunt" Sweepstakes ("Sweepstakes") is open to legal residents of Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach and Monroe counties who are 18 years of age or older as of 04/13/08. The Sweepstakes is sponsored by Washington Post (R) ("Sponsor"). The Sweepstakes is administered by the Miami Herald Holding Company (a subsidiary of The McClatchy Company), located at One Herald Plaza, Miami, Florida 33132 ("Administrator") (collectively "Sweepstakes Entities"). Employees, directors and officers of Sweepstakes Entities, The McClatchy Company and their respective parent companies, affiliated companies, subsidiaries and any of their agents, advertising, promotional and other agencies, and the immediate families and persons living in the same household of such employees/directors/officers are not eligible to enter the Sweepstakes or win a prize.

TO ENTER:

(1) On-Line: During the Sweepstakes Period, find the entry at www.miamiherald.com, click on Contests.

Entry forms will also be available at the MH Office.

Entries must be received no later than April 28, 2008. Entrants may enter as many times as they like.

Sweepstakes Entities are not responsible for late, lost, delayed, damaged, misdirected, incomplete, illegible, unintelligible, or postage-due entries and reserve the right to disqualify entries that are incomplete, illegible or suspected of being false. Only complete valid entries will be accepted. All entries submitted become the sole property of Sweepstakes Entities and will not be acknowledged or returned.

DRAWING: A random drawing will be held on or about April 28, 2008 and two (2) entrants will be selected from among all eligible entries to each receive one Prize ("Selected Entrants").

Selected Entrants will be notified by phone using the information provided on the original entry form. Unless restricted by law, each Selected Entrant will be required to complete and return an eligibility / liability / publicity release "Release") within the time period specified therein.
